The ideal kinds of essays for our purposes are those in which you perform a researched reading of a literary text. In any case, choose two essays that:

Include **close-readings** of primary texts,
Show evidence of **research**, including the use of secondary sources,
Demonstrate familiarity with **theory or criticism**, and
Represent your **best**, **most substantive** critical work.
