

# **Education in the Health Professions Track (EHP)**

The IDD M.S. program now offers education and training of healthcare professionals in various contexts. This includes healthcare professionals and other healthcare-related professionals.

- Apply current research findings
- Develop and implement healthcare policies

## **Program Structure**

The EHP Track has a unique curriculum designed specifically for healthcare professionals. It follows the core curriculum of the IDD program but focuses on practical application in healthcare settings.
