## Guidelines For The Use of Space Heaters

The University of South Alabama recognizes that individuals have different levels of comfort associated with temperature and heat. We understand that some areas are more difficult to heat than others. In areas where this problem exists the temporary use of electric space heaters may be permitted if the following guidelines are followed:

- x Fuelpowered (propanexerosene)spaceheatersarenot permitted. Spacebeaters must not takemore than 10 volts.
- x Any space heaters used must be(**U**bderwritersLaboratory)approved.
- x Approved spaceheatersmustbefan driven. Space heatewisch heatedcoils are not permitted.
- x Space heaters shall heat thermostat that shutter when a certain temperature is reached.
- x Space heaters shall hear tip-overshutdown feature.
- x Spaceheatersmustbeplugged into awall receptacle. Extension corslsall not be used.
- x Spaceheaterswith wattagecontrolsshall not besetabove1 00 watts.
- x Spaceheaters without manual controls hall not be more than 100 watts.
- x Spaceheatersmustalwaysbeturned offand unplugged when the alleging heated is not ccupied.
- x Space heaters must be kept at least 3 feet from any combustible materials.
- x Nothingshall be placed on top of paceheaters.
- x Hot plates and to a stee oven should never be used for spaceheating.
- x Space heaters not allowed in labs where chemicals are used.

The University of South Alabama Safety and Environmental Compliance Department reserves the right to inspect and declar approved any space heater that creates a hazard or is inappropriate to a particular location based on specific circumstances, code or legal requirements.
